Technology Safety for Students

- ◆ Parents best practices monitor, supervise and limit Video Gaming, Social Networking, Chatting and Texting sites: use privacy settings, students should only friend people you know, set profiles to private!
- ◆ No sharing personal or private information online
- ◆ No Geo-tagging student pictures this reveals locations
- ◆ Healthy eyes 20/20 rule: look away from technology every 20 minutes for 20 seconds.
- ◆ Healthy ears 50/50 rule: volume not higher than 50% not longer than 50 minutes, best practice earmuffs.
- ◆ Technology posture and technique is important take breaks often.
- ◆ Risks from using Free Wi-Fi; it is not secure from Hackers & Viruses user beware.
- ◆ School policies address “cyberbullying” from home or school. Its against the law in NJ.
- ◆ Sexting when teenagers under 18 years send inappropriate pictures of themselves or other minors. This is now a criminal offense in NJ.
